1. I advised Mr. Mario Noto, Deputy Assistant ~~Commissioner~~ Commissioner, Investigations Division, INS, of Mr. Wisner's reply to their request for an interview. Mr. Noto was loathe to accept it as final although he was sympathetic with Mr. Wisner's position. He said he would report that while Mr. Wisner did not want to be interviewed at this time, he would leave the door open for some later approach.

2. We talked some more and I explained that Mr. Wisner's views and knowledge of the case had been secured at an earlier date and had been incorporated in the material which we had made available to INS. It was highly unlikely, therefore, that an interview with Mr. Wisner would be profitable to INS. Mr. Noto finally agreed that they would drop their request. What they are seeking is an informal interview in the

hopes that Mr. Wisner can furnish some interpretation or clue which would provide them with additional leads. This is now their top priority case and they will leave no stone unturned.

3. I told Mr. Noto to please call on us for any other assistance we might be able to provide and he assured me that he would.

4. The conversation was extremely pleasant and Mr. Noto entirely understanding. I am not sure, however, that General Swing will let the idea of an interview drop.
