2. AFL WAS FOUNDED ON 13 DEC 1966 IN BONN. IT IS A NON-PARTY ORGANIZATION DEDICATED TO GERMAN UNITY AND FREEDOM THROUGH FREE ELECTIONS AND SELF-DETERMINATION. AFL FURTHER-MORE SUPPORTS EUROPEAN UNITY AND THE ATLANTIC ALLIANCE. THROUGH DISCUSSIONS AND PRINTED WORK THE AFL ATTEMPTS TO COVER ALL ASPECTS OF FOREIGN, DOMESTIC AND ECONOMIC SECURITY. THE GOALS OF THE AFL ARE CARRIED OUT THROUGH PUBLICATIONS, SEMINARS AND SPECIAL EVENTS,

3. THE AFL HAS ABOUT 450 DUES PAYING MEMBERS FROM ALL PARTIES, REGIONS AND PROFESSIONS, BUT THE MAJORITY (56 PER CENT) ARE FROM THE LARGEST PROVINCE, NORTH RHINE-WESTPHALIA. 4. ANNUAL DUES ARE DM 60 FOR FULL MEMBERS AND DM 20 FOR STUDENTS AND ORAFTEES.

5. THE AFL DISTRIBUTES VIA MAIL ABOUT 1.000 PAMPHLETS AND PUBLICATIONS A MONTH AND HELD 60 SEMINARS ON DEFENSE SUB-JECTS DURING CALENDAR YEAR 1982. MUELLER-GOLTZ (MG) GAVE US SAMPLES OF MATERIAL DISTRIBUTED, WHICH INCLUDED MOD PUBLICATIONS. NATO INFORMATION SHEETS. U.S. EMBASSY ICA MATERIAL AND A PAM-PHLET BY CONGRESSMAN LES ASPIN ENTITLED "JUDGE NOT BY NUMBERS ALONE: U.S. MILITARY POSTURE" PUBLISHED BY THE EDUCATIONAL FOUNDATION FOR NUCLEAR SCIENCE AND DISTRIBUTED BY ICA.

6. MG ASKED C/O TO RETURN FOR A FURTHER DISCUSSION WITH THE AFL BUSINESS MANAGER. KARL-HEINZ ((MARBACH)). AND THE CHAIRMAN, HANS ((PETERS)).

7. IT IS INTERESTING TO NOTE THAT MG WAS EXTREMELY FRIENDLY AND FORTHCOMING WHEN HE HEARD C/O WAS FROM U.S. EMBASSY. "HE STATED FRANKLY THAT ABOUT TWO YEARS AGO THE LONG TERM CHAIRMAN AND FOUNDER OF AFL. FNU GRUENTHAL. WAS VOTED OUT OF OFFICE AND REPLACED BY HANS PETERS. GRUENTHAL IS A FULL TIME CIVIL SERVANT EMPLOYED BY THE MINISTRY OF DEFENSE AND HAD DOMINATED THE ORGANI-ZATION FOR YEARS. GRUENTHAL HAS SINCE FOUNDED A NEW ORGANIZATION. SINCE HIS DEPARTURE, AFL HAS LOST SOME OF ITS FINANCIAL SUPPORT AND AT PRESENT IS IN PROCESS OF TRYING TO RAISE ADDITIONAL FUNDS AND RECRUIT NEW MEMBERS.
