As stated in Reference B, the documents which originated with various allied intelligence organizations during WW II refer to Gustav MEISSNER with many epithets, e.g. vicious, fanatical Nazi, etc. The picture that emerges from reading the British post-war detailed interrogation report and the material from overt publications, however, does not place him in such a bad light. Because of this disparity which can probably never be resolved, we enclose herewith the pertinent Headquarters documents on MEISSNER.
