4. REPORT OF FINDINGS

On 14 May 1953 the files of 430th CIC Sub-Detachment A were examined by this Agent concerning personalities mentioned in this report, and the following information was revealed:

Serhejy Bowdij is identical with one Sergei Bowdiyi, born 26 September 1925 in Werbiwka, USSR, mentioned in Agent Report, S-15930, dated 10 December 1952, Subject: Request for Check, as residing in DP Camp Parsch, Barrack 9, Room 23, Salzburg, Land Salzburg, Austria. He is listed as an individual whose case is missing from the police files. He was screened on 14 August 1952 for employment with the Provost Marshal Office as a guard; but dismissed per action sheet dismissal, dated 14 August 1952, Ref. III2g, not subject to appeal, for having been sentenced to 1951 to seven weeks' imprisonment for unauthorized possession of weapons.

Petro Holowinskyj is probably identical with one Peter Holowinski, born 10 April 1925 in Hohouym, Poland, the subject of a DP 48 case.

Stepan or Stefan Bandera is mentioned in numerous reports in the files of this Sub-Detachment as a leader of a resistance group in the Ukraine.

Josef Berest is probably identical with one Josef Berest, born 21 September 1900 in Lwow, Poland, residing at Lans 47 bei Innsbruck, Land Tyrol, Austria, the subject of a DP 48 case.

Stahij Koslo is identical with one Eustachius Kocle, born 17 September 1904 in Tryncza, Poland, the subject of a DP 48 case.

Colonel Andrij Melnyk is probably identical with one Colonel Andrew Melnyk, mentioned in numerous reports in the files of this Sub-Detachment as the leader of a Soviet resistance group, the Organization of the Ukrainian Nationalists.

Aleksander Lawryezyn is identical with one Alexander Lawryszyn, born 15 March 1903 in Bendery, Romania, the subject of a DP 48 case.

Wolodymyr Radlowskyj is identical with one Wolodymyr Radlowskyj, born 18 December 1907 in Whyoda, Poland, residing in DP Camp Landeck, the subject of a DP 48 case.

Dmytro Wozczak is possibly identical with one Dimitro Wozczak, born 22 October 1922 in Rows-Ruska, Poland, the subject of a DP 48 case.

Neonila Sasyk is probably identical with one Neolina Sasyk or Neonila Holone Sasyk, born 30 August 1912 in Borislav, Poland, residing in DP Camp Vorkloster, Bregenz, Land Vorarlberg, Austria, the subject of a DP 48 case.

Iwan Schkwarko is identical with one Iwan Szkwarko, born 7 March 1901 in Zwenyhorod, Poland, the subject of a DP 48 case.

Petronella Schachinger may be identical with one Petronella Schachinger, born 5 May 1908 in Salzburg, residing at Salzburg-Lehen, Wallner-gasse 6, an NSDAP (Nazi Party) member since 1938 and the recipient of a six month border pass on 22 September 1949.

Dr. Ljubimir Buczynskyj is probably identical with Dr. Jnr. Lubomir Butschinski, residing on Hellbrunnerallee, Salzburg, listed as having been screened on 1 September 1945 for employment with the Military Government, and on 11 October 1945 for employment with Special Branch of Military Government; no security objection was found. An unnumbered report, this Sub-Detachment, dated 11 July 1946, mentions Butschinski as in possession of an unauthorized CIC document.

Dmytroff Bobanycz may be identical with one Dr. Dmytro Bobanich, residing in DP Camp Hellbrunn, Salzburg, mentioned in Agent Report, S-16671, dated 11 February 1953, Subject: Ukrainian Refugee Activities, Land Salzburg, Salzburg, Austria, (Evaluation F-3), as president of UCDOA. One Demeter or Dmytro Bobanycz, born 7 November 1887 in Synowidsko, Stryl, Poland, is the subject of a DP 48 case.

Father Ivan Daszkowskyj may be identical with one Johannes Daschkowskyj, born 11 August 1921 in Lemberg, Poland, listed in Agent Report, S-15455, dated 14 November 1952, Subject: DP's of Soviet Nationality, as residing in Barrack 30, Room 1, DP Camp Hellbrunn, Salzburg.

Dr. Wolodymyr Iwanowycz is probably identical with one Wolodymyr Iwanowycz, a physician, born 14 March 1905 in Topciwci, Romania, residing in Barrack A, Room 1, DP Camp Volksgarten, Salzburg, listed in the files of this Sub-Detachment as having been screened

on 10 November 1950 for employment with IRO Central Headquarters, Lehenerkasern, Salzburg, as substitute chief doctor, and on 3 March 1952 for employment with the 9th Station Hospital, Camp Truscott, Salzburg; on the latter date he was cleared for a nonsensitive position indefinitely.

Platon Rusynko may be identical with one Platon Rusinko, born 31 October 1903 in Lemberg, Poland, residing in DP Camp Siezenheim, Salzburg, the subject of a DP 48 case who was screened on 14 May 1946 for employment with UNRRA.

Mykola Liszczynskij may be identical with one Mykola Liszczynskij born 9 August 1911 in Czernowits, Romania, the subject of a DP 48 case who was screened on 27 March 1952 for employment with 430th CIC Sub-Detachment A as a janitor, and cleared on 20 March 1952 for a nonsensitive position indefinitely. Agent Report, S-15455, dated 14 November 1952, Subject: DP's of Soviet Nationality, lists him as residing in Barrack 5, Room 4 of DP Camp Parsch.

Michael Iahola may be identical with one Michael Iahola, born 18 November 1889 in Erzwlooczna, Poland, residing at Iahser See Hotel, Innsbruck, Land Tyrol, Austria, the subject of a DP 48 case.

Dr. Mykola Makarenko may be identical with one Mykola Makarenko, a veterinarian, born 6 December 1905 in Stanislaw, Poland, the subject of a DP 48 case.

Dr. Leonid Mostowycz may be identical with one Leonidas Mostowycz, born 4 October 1918 in Berezno, Poland, residing at Rechenweg 15, Innsbruck, the subject of a DP 48 case.

Josef or Osip Tiuska may be identical with one Osyp (Osip) Tiuschka (Tiuszka), born 20 March 1908 in Misun, Galicia, residing at Vogelweidenstrasse 4, Innsbruck, the subject of a DP 48 case who was rejected for immigration under Section 13 of Public Law 774.

Sonowia Panczura may be identical with one Sonowia Panczura, born 21 December 1921 in Kilmea, Poland, residing at Prinz Eugenstrasse 60, Innsbruck, the subject of a DP 48 case.

Wasył Noga may be identical with one Wasyl Noga, born 29 April 1913 in Rosochacz, Poland, residing in DP Camp Landeck, the subject of a DP 48 case.
