In response to the concern previously voiced by the Station regarding the possible consequences of a public issue over allegations against Dr. Hans Globke, Chancellor Adenauer's senior aide, we are forwarding herewith as background material a number of articles and letters taken from the <u>New York Times</u> which debate the Globke case. While there appear to be solid arguments pro and con which obscure the issue, it is hoped that the statements defending Globke could if necessary be replayed with good effect, in particular the 26 February 1960 letter from Dr. G. N. Shuster.</p> <p>2. It is possible that Eichmann, as the 18 February 1961 article reported, may refrain from mentioning Globke at all, in which case we may hopefully avoid the issue entirely. In any case the Station is welcome to use the articles however the situation develops.
