MEMORANDUM: FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT : Report of meeting with AEPRIMER - 1

1. The undersigned held a personal meeting with Subject from 1630 to 1705 on 4 June 1958, in New York City, N. Y.

2. The following, of operational interest, was discussed:

- a. REDSKIN candidates.
- b. AEPRIMER - 1's training in Washington, D. C.
- c. Spotting salary for May was paid.

3. Subject informed the undersigned that he is holding in abeyance two REDSKIN candidates until such time as the undersigned informs him to proceed with the recruitment. The undersigned informed Subject that at the present moment legal travelers to Byelorussian SSR are of interest and will continue to be of interest. However, for purposes of long range activity travelers from Byelorussia who are returning to that country after a visit in the United States are of slightly greater importance, operationally speaking. Subject has undersigned that he will make greater efforts in this direction.

Subject was informed that his training has been scheduled for the period 7 - 11 July 1958 in Washington, D. C. Subject is to contact the undersigned via the ADAMS line when he arrives in Washington, D. C. in order to arrange for further contact. Subject was also given the names of two motels, The White House Motel and the Anchorage Motel, both in Virginia, as places to which he could write for reservations for himself and family.

Subject was paid his spotting salary for the month of May, for which he signed a receipt.
