SUPPLEMENTARY
AGREEMENT

The following assurances are added to the request for transfer of prisoner to the Landesgericht fuer Straf-
sachen Vienna.

a) In the event of acquittal the prisoner will not be released until the American authorities concerned have been notified of the acquittal and have indicated whether or not the prisoner is to be returned to U.S. control.

b) In the event a conviction is obtained and imprisonment imposed by the Austrian court, the Austrian court will notify the American authorities concerned of the sentence and will not release the internee upon the expiration of the sentence without ascertaining whether or not the American authorities desire the prisoner returned to U.S. custody.

c) In any case where the American authorities deem a sentence imposed by the Austrian court inadequate, or desire, for any other reason, to gain custody of the prisoner, the internee will be surrendered promptly.

d) The Austrian court guarantees the safe-keeping of all political prisoners released to its custody by the American authorities and will provide the safe transportation for transferring said prisoners from camp "Marcus Orlik" to the session hall and return.

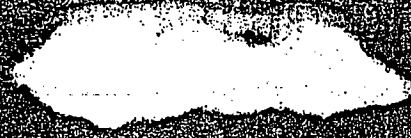

1. Summary of Arrest: ZEISCHKA was arrested at Bad Ischl, Austria, by C/O Detachment 90 Infantry Division on 12 July 1945 because he was a member of the SD. He arrived at Third US Army Intelligence Center on 20 August 1945.

2. Summary of Background: Viktor Zeischka is an Austrian and was born in Bad Ischl, Austria, in 1909 and the Allgemeine SS in 1935. Between 1929 and 1935 he was a policeman in WIEN. In 1935 he was discharged from the police force because of his Nazi activities. He then served in the Austrian Legion and in 1936 was taken into the RSHA. He attended a course in the Fuehrerschule, Berlin, and graduated as Kriminalkommissar. From 1938 to 1942 he was in the employ of the ALLGEMEINE DEUTSCHE ARBEITSDIENSTVERBAND in Vienna. He was in charge of the plant for the production of synthetic rubber in the department. In 1942 he re-joined the RSHA as a liaison man between Amt VI and the Ministry of Propaganda. In June 1944 he was transferred to Amt VI 3 (South Asia) for which office he dealt with the representatives of the exiled governments of Bulgaria, Rumania, and Croatia.

3. Disposition: ZEISCHKA is a Hauptsturmfuehrer in the Allgemeine SS and a member of the RSHA, which places him in the automatic West German detention category. He is to be evacuated to a British internment camp.
