attached information has been received from OSTRICH during the paris noted above. Since the date of these interrogations it has been determined that Plane LAGARDERE AFRANCINE and Mimil CUINAND are in Paris and will be arrested shortly. Joan BARBOT and Rome NEY are also known to be in Paris and steps are being taken for their apprehension. Marcel DUNKER alias Marcel DALERIS and Flanche GIEU @ Maria ROSSI have been arrested, by the ST of Marsellos and have been brought to Paris for interrogation.

There were also seven other French people whose names OSTRICH does not know. He gave their cover names to Vaptains Masse of the Securite Militaire at Froiburg.

In addition OSTRICH mentions Pierre LACARDERE, Elmond COLOMBANI, and Gorard LITT. There were two women with LACARDERE, one named Francine and the other Mimi GUINAND (?). Mme. VLIEGEN and her son, Mme. ZELLER and her son, and Mme. HARREL were to remain in the Waldsruhe Villa at Badenweiler. In addition, according to OSTRICH, there was a French maid who came with the group from Bolfort.

Because the original plans of the Kommando could not be parrhed out DUFFNER decided to form small groups of capable people and have them join in the guarilla warfare.

According to the last orders given by HESEKOW, Plante LACARDERE was to be passed into Switzerland by the WALZ organization with Francisc and Mint GUINAND and they were then to go on to France. OSTRICH fools that this plan could not have been carried out because of the shortness of time.

The group of seven French people whose names OSTRICH does not know were to be sent with Obersturmfuchrer DOBROWICH to NEISSER in San Reme, but again OSTRICH feels that the preject could not have been carried out because of the lack of time.

The group made up of DUNKER, MARTIN, GIEU, OLIVIERI and MARTINI was split up by OSTRICH who caused trouble between DUNKER and his mistress GIEU and amoung the other men with the result, according to OSTRICH, that the group will not be in action anymore.

About the 15 April DUFFNER sont a truck to the Ausweissquartier of Amt VI/S which at that time was at Hof or Altal in Bavaria, for obtaining sabotage material. OSTRICH does not know if the truck returned or not.

Kommando HAGEN is now, according to OSTRICH, in the Vjugendhorborgo! at Schlacchtenhausen where they have a food dump and a substage material dump.

DESCRIPTIONS

Hans DUFFNER: Sturmbannfuehrer. About 38, looks 45; lm72; medium build; blond; type of poot and thinker. Pharmacist. Was with the SD in Paris and Vichy.

Hormann VALENTIN: Unterscharfuehrer. About 33; lm82; extremely strongly built; very thin brown hair. Speaks good French.

Fritz FINKLER: Unterschärfuehrer. 28; 1m68; very thin, very hollow checks; long thin prominent nose; brown hair; bad stomach. Born in Metz.

HENNINGER: SS Soldat. About 40, looks 30; lm66; small and thin; light brown hair. Speaks good Fronch. Formerly in Foreign Logion.

Josoph SCHOLZ: Unteroffizier. lm70; slender; brown hair; slightly offeminate walk. Wears Luftwaffe uniform. Instructor in radio,

WEGENER: nickname DEDDI - Stabsgefreiter and Verwaltungsfurhrer for Kommando HAGEN. lm66; small; very thin; light brown hair; lisps.

DUNKER: alias Marcol DALERIS - SS Soldat. Native town Halle. 33; 1m70; brown hair, thin; speaks French and English. Has been in the Stated and England.

Joan BARBOT: Unterscharfuchrer. 24; 1m72; slender; very black hair; brown eyes; formerly LVF. French.

Jean (?) OLIVIERI: alias Romas RICCI - Unterscharfuchrer. 28; lm65-66; slender; very dark hair; prominent nose. Typical Corsicar. Nervous in his movements.

Louis MARINI: 33; lm84; slender; very long curly black hair; eagle noso. Spanish origin. Spouks Fronch with Spanish accent. Untorscharfuchrer.

Leo MARTIN: Covor namo; 25; lm75; slendor; black hair.

Hlancho GIFU: alias Maria ROSSI - 24; small delicate build; hair combed high in a pempadour. Mistress of DUNKER.

Edmond COLOMBANI: About 4.0; lm70; brown bushy hair; vory deep voice; one leg paralyzed. Is said to have been a sous-prefet in the south of France. Corsican.

Francine X: 26; 1m67; very dark; fairly heavy; potty brunette.

Mimi GUINAND: 28; lm67; brunette. Comes from Normandy. Pregnant.

When OSTRICH first saw HESEKOW and SKORZENY at the end of January there was a discussion about the possibility of attempts against the lives of various military and political personalities. OSTRICH was told that an attempt against DE GAULLE was not desirable at that moment, but that, on the contrary, attempts against the lives of prominent Communists like THOREZ were desirable.

OSTRICH also stated that later on while he was at belonweller he del'vered a lecture to several high SS officers about the general situation in France. At the end of the lecture Hauntstrumfüchrer KURAT and Oberleutanat DERKSEN asked OSTRICH what he thought of General De Lattre De Tassimy. They asked him if he thought it would be of any use to get into direct contact with notassimy. They also asked OSTRICH if he thought De Tassimy was pro-American, if he were not more friendly to the English, or if he were possibly accessible to the idea of a Europe for the Europeans and to the idea of collaboration between Germany and France against the Communists. CSTRICH was not told whether they were going to try to get in touch with De Tassigny or not, but in later discussions which he everheard between KURAT and DERKSEN and other SS and SD people OSTRICH thought there must exist some idea on the part of the Germans of getting into touch with De Tassigny and that perhaps Standartenfuchrer HICKLER had actually made an attempt already.

1 May 1945.

OSTRICH gave the following information about Kommando ADLER Which he says is a Wehrmacht undertaking.

The Kormandoruehrer is Oberleutnant MERCK alias Captain KAISER whose description is as follows: 38; about 1m70; strong build; light brown hair; asthmatic; wears Wehrmacht uniform and always wears a silk scarf.

The headquarters of the Kommando was in a hostelry, Gaststacte Waldhorn at Schweighof near Badenweiler. The Kommando is under the orders of the To of the XVIIL SS AK Hauptsturmfunhrer KUBAT and has about thirty members. The purpose of Kommando ADLER was Frontaufklaerungand intelligence work behind the Allied lines but KUBAT told OSTRICH that the Kommando had never succeeded in accomplishing anything despite the fact that they had been given special gas rations. OSTRICH saw the Kommando for the last time about the 15th of April and has no further information about it.

Under Kommando ADLER there were two other Kommandos. One was the Kommando KIERITZ whose headquarters were in the restamant Zum Krone at Sulzburg. The Kommando weak Untereffizier OTT whose description is as follows; about 35-36; lm65; brown hair slightly groying; wears glasses; smokes a pipe. Swiss from the Canton of Zurich. Speaks German and French with a Swiss accent. This Kommando was under Obergrefreiter Johnny PLUMI from Cologno who was with FONIN last autumn in the Villa Sans Souci at Gerardmor. PLUM was transferred about 12 April contrary to MERCK's wishes to the Sonderkommando Bedonweiler. PLUM's description is as follows: about 38; lm62; light brown hair; married with two children (his wife and children were with him); formerly a barman; has a high thin voice like a woman's. The purpose of Kommando KIEHITZ was the same as that of Kommando ADLER and like it has accomplished nothing.

Also under Kommando ADLER was the Kommando at Kandorn. OSTRICH does not know the name of the Kommando and knows only one member of the group, Louis DECEDRE alias Louis CHEVALIER. The Kommando moved to Freiburg about the 10th of April where its headquarters were on the Kronostrasse. The Kommandofuehrer was interoffizier/ WITTMANN whose description is as follows; about 33; lm78; fairly strong build; light brown hair; nose bent to one side; red face; always in civilian elothes. Speaks good French. When OSTRICH saw WITTMANN about the 15th of April WITTMANN told him that the Kommando was going to move to Waldkirch. OSTRICH says that the jurpose of Kommando was the same as that of Kommando ADLER and like it, has also accomplished nothing.

OSTRICH also gave some information about a Kommando at Munsterhalden (Untermunsteral). This Kommando was under the direct orders of Hauptsturmfuchrer KUBAT. The Kommandofuchrer was Untersturmfuchrer PERNER whose description is: about 35; lm75; slender athletic appearance; very blond thin hair; blue eyes; squashed nose; takes good care or the men under him and is admired by them; speaks good French; an Austrian. The description of Hauptsturmfuchrer KUBAT is as follows: 33; lm68; young and open face; blond hair; formerly in the Wehrmacht and was a battallion chief on the Russian front; in 1942 was a simple soldier and became an officer because of his courage; has several high decorations; comes from the Eger region of the Sudetenland.

KUBAT asked Ostrich to visit the members of the Kommando located in the mountains at Untermunstertal and during the first part of April Ostrich went there. The day he arrived five of FERNER's non were preparing to leave via Switzerland for France in order to carry out a short mission for the purpose of gathering military information. This group was under the orders of an Alsatian called HAMM Ostrich does not know whether this was a cover or a real name. HAMM was 33; ln70; heavily built; dark brown hair very large mouth; bad tooth. He had a number of high decorations. The group was to be back within a week but had not returned at the end of a fortnight. KUBAT said that he had successfully sent a man across the Allied lines each week and that they had even sent non back across the Rhine. They had been successful in obtaining military i "ermation but they had done no sabetage. The group under HAMM were to be he ped through Switzerland by the Organisation WALZ.

Ostrich also gave some information of Organisation WALZAwhich is headed by Obersturn Hebrer WALZAwhon Ostrich know in Mulhausen in 1942.
WALZ is running an organisation which helps people to pass through Switzerland into France. Through his contacts in Switzerland WALZ is able to pass groups of five and six men into France. With the help of a Swiss customs official at the Franzachef Horn to whom WALZ gives information on people in Switzerland who are wanted for arrest, thus enabling the Swiss customs official to get in the good graces of his superiors, WALZ sends his men by car through Switzerland directly to Montbeliard and Bosancon. When they arrive at the French frontier they pose as inspectors of French food supplies. Oberleutnant DERKSEN, Kompaniefuchrer of Kompanie Skorpion Rheingau Propaganda Abteilung, told Ostrich that with the aid of WALZ's organisation he had been able to spend a wook in France at the end of March travelling as an inspector of food supplies. Ostrich says that WALZ had his headquarters in the building of the Landgericht in Lorrach. WALZ also had his own radio station and a Getante Aussenstelle at Gronzach in the Cafe Eskert. Mention was frequently made of an Untersturnfuchrer EKERT but Ostrich does not know if there is any connection between EKERT and the Cafe Ekert.

The following people were connected with Organisation W/JZ.

WALZ: real name MALZACHER X
42; lm73; light brown curly hair; stooping walk; distinguished
looking; always wears civilian clothes; gomes from the region
between Basle and Constance. Was chief of the Ast at Alykirch inAlsace.

Oberloutnant. 1,5; lm68; heavy set; very short hair cut; typical German official; comes from the region of Lorrach.

Kurt FISCHER: Hauptmann X
about 35; 1=75; blond; slender; badly wounded in the shoulder and
in other parts of the body; plays poker.

Loro MUEHLICH:
Secretary. 1:65; brown hair combod high.

Ostrich also said about W/IZ that the two of them had been close friends but that after WALZ had heard the story told by TONIN about Ostrich, WALZ was extremely suspicious of him.

Ostrich also reported on the Kompani Skorpion Rheingau Propaganda Abteilung of the XVIII SS AK which was under the orders of the Ic of the XVIII SS AK Hauptsturnfuchrer KUBAT. Kompanie Skorpion was composed chiefly of members of the SS Propaganda Standarte Kurt EGGERS. There were between sixty to seventy men in the Kompanie. The headquarters of the Kompanie was at Untermunstertal and the Kompanie fuchrer was Oberleutnant DERKSEN. The purpose of Kompanie was to spread propaganda among the French troops. They sent ever tracts contained in specially made gronades; they put up big signs along the Rhine bank; they sent over propaganda in ges-filled balloons or in Montgolfieri balloons. In addition they were supposed to encourage the German troops at the front.

Three aussenstellen which were called trupps made up Kompanie Skorpion. The first Trupp was in Wasser between Freiburg and Openburg. This was the calloon trupp. The second trupp was at Schweighof near Balenweiler and the third at Kandern between Balenweiler and Lorrach. The last two trupps were especially for slogans, tracts and signs.

unit. Journalist in civilian life. Comes from Bromen. Speaks
very good English and was in England for a long time.
School friend of Charlie HAGEDORN's.

Heinrich CERNAND:

Frohmen of Kompanie Stampion Truep at Schweighof.

Unterscharfuehrer.

About 50; ImS2-InSt; blond carly hair; blue eyes; very good-looking; comes from a poor family of Kassel; old Nazi party nember and was a Standartonfuchrer in the Allgeheine SS.

During 1942-14 was an advisor attached to the German cubassy at Copenhagon and Stockhom.

While OSTRICH was in Freiburg in March and April he reports that he frequently saw some young non and women who obviously belonged to some organization. OSTRICH states that he not a young woman who belonged to this group. Her name was Hildegard HAUCK who was an embroiderer, small and brunette. She told OSTRICH that the group had about twenty members under the orders of a Major HALS. The headquarters of the group was at Wilhelm Gustloffstrasse 19, Freiburg. They were instructed in radio and were to be stay-behind W/T agents after the Allied occupation. OSTRICH knows nothing further about the organization.
