(9) A Heidelberg report (MHA 620), dated 30 September 1948, indicated that FARKAS visited Austria several times during April, May and June 1948. The alleged reasons for his visits being to contact Dr. Karoly NEY, former Sturmabfuhrer in the Hungarian SS. FARKAS is generally met by former Hungarian Colonel Karoly MERENYI, who reportedly works for CIC Brauman at the border. DR. NEY was allegedly commissioned by FAR AS to organize a "Legion of Death" from young men who are escaping from Hungary to avoid military service there. ....
