TITLE CONSCIOUSNESS Physics (Parapsychology)
The Reality and The Threat

time 20 Minutes

Objectives Each student should

1. Be able to describe succinctly and clearly, given a photograph three aspects of elementary physics:
 - (1) Elementary Particles: wave like - particle like behavior which waxes in and out of existence
 - (2) Field of Energy: unknown ocean like reality which gives rise to wave like - particle behavior according to dynamic laws which are little understood even today.
 - (3) EPR Paradox: Particles born as twins are tied together and ^{continue to} affect one another through the original relationship even through a universe apart
2. Be able to describe from memory basic parapsychological and consciousness ^{PHYSICS} events at least:
 - (1) Remote viewing: ~~Being able to describe~~ Being able to see and describe distant events and places with some degree of detailed accuracy.
 - (2) Telekinesis: Being able to concentrate well and consciousness on a physical object to cause it to change shape, molecular ~~structure~~ structure or to leave its location.
 - (3) EMPATHETIC EVENT: People with strong emotional bonds especially identical twins are able through the bond relationship to feel or know what another person is experiencing
4. Be able to describe from memory the basic intelligence threat posed by the capabilities noted above at least the following
 - (1) COMSAC: Enemy being able to see and describe crypt keys by remote viewing and being able to ~~distant intelligence~~ distant intelligence

by means of Telekinesis

(2) SIGINT: ENEMY is able to see by remote viewing information on the source of SIGINT or be able to shut down or disrupt communication intercept gear by means of Telekinesis.

3 Be able to describe from memory three different aspects of consciousness ^{states} which are factors of ordinary consciousness and three which are factors of para-consciousness states:

(1) ordinary consciousness aspects: sense of time (clock time); sense of identity (separate discrete); sense of place (near and distant separations)

2 Paraconsciousness aspects: sense of time (all is now); sense of identity (close to another); sense of place (near and distant places overlap)

Lesson Plan Part II Presentation

Gaining Attention: I relate the following story: one of the students in our class a number of years ago had a fiancé who was a pilot in Vietnam. The day he was shot down over N. Vietnam, his mother and father were asleep at home in the U.S. The mother stated that the picture suddenly fell off the wall with a loud bang! She awoke startled and said to her husband "Oh! My God! something terrible has just happened to Chris" Subsequent checking of time indicated that this waking event took place just about the same time that the pilot was being shot down. By the way, he was recovered alive by a search and rescue team.

Motivation These talents will directly affect the degree of protection we are able to afford our government communications and SIGINT sources. Often such events also emerge suddenly to give us warning of personal dangers.

1. Summary Statement. The basic aspects of Elementary modern physics which we considered were: particles, which actually exhibit wave like and particle like behavior as they work in and out of existence; a field which is ocean like and gives rise to particles and the EPR Paradox relationship which observes that twinned particles affect each other through their relationship continually regardless of distance. Related to these fundamental concepts are basic parapsychological and consciousness physics events such as: Remote viewing the ability to see and describe distant events or objects; Telekinesis, focusing consciousness and will to alter shape structure or location of matter and the EMPATHETIC EVENT where people with strong emotional bonds are able through the bond to feel or know what is happening

to another person. We looked at some basic differences between the aspects of ordinary consciousness: sense of time which is clock time; sense of identity-separate, and sense of place which is a separation of near and distant places, and the aspects of Paraconsciousness: sense of time which is now time; sense of identity which is close to another and sense of place which allows overlap between near and distant places.

Finally we considered how these capabilities of consciousness physics are able to be used to pose a threat to COMSEC: Remote viewing allows someone to describe key while Telekinesis enables someone to adversely affect communications circuitry. SIGINT is concerned that remote viewing can reveal sources or that Telekinesis can cause destruction or disruption of communications intercept circuits.

2 Concluding Statement We in the Agency must become knowledgeable about the threats and opportunities posed by the capabilities of consciousness physics. These capabilities affect both COMSEC and SIGINT in a serious manner. Their inventions use can have a devastating effect on people's mental and physical health.
