<u>OGATA Taketora</u> was reported to have been Prime Minister YOSHIDA's choice for the post of Director General of the National Safety Agency, but last minute opposition within the Liberal Party appears to have compelled YOSHIDA to abandon this plan momentarily. YOSHIDA will assume the post himself for the time being. Opposition to OGATA is supposedly based upon his participation in wartime Cabinet as State Minister since this would preclude the Liberals from attacking the Progressive Reform Party in the coming general election on the grounds that President SHIGEMITSU was a wartime collaborator. OGATA has been identified with several ultranationalist organizations and is definitely farther to the right than any of the present members of the YOSHIDA Cabinet.
