Abolishment of National Personnel Authority: The government has decided to seek cabinet approval on 5 Mar of a proposed amendment to the National Public Service Law which will abolish the National Personnel Authority (NPA). A change from the existing semi independent NPA to a National Personnel Commission as an external agency entirely under the jurisdiction of the Prime Minister's Office has been under discussion for some time. Recommendations made by the Provisional Administrative Reorganization Headquarters of the Cabinet in early Feb 1954 have been somewhat revised after Administrative Management Agency Director General TSUKADA Juichiro discussed the problem with the NAPA and other government agencies.
