Sometime before Colonel C's retirement I spoke
to him concerning the possibility of obtaining an
extra copy of "General Summary of Japanese Intelligence
Activities In Scandinavia" for the information of our
Washington office. He stated that it would be possible
for Washington to have a copy, but was not certain as
to the policy with regard to a still additional copy
to Scandinavia. In the latter situation he would no
doubt have been guided by the general Section V policy
toward its own field station. In the confusion of his
retirement no copy has been received by us for Wash-
ington nor any statement as to whether an additional
one can be procured for the Stockholm desk. Could
you cope?
