Salsinger's job had mainly been checking of security and violations of military discipline. As is known by German Intelligence reports, the Germans have always been more lenient than their opponents. In his work, however, Salsinger made no distinction with members of other branches of the service and also Intelligence Agents not assigned to him. Thus, he once organized a banquet for General Odo (at present on Military Attache in Stockholm, and Col. Yamamoto (at present on Military Attache in Berlin. This banquet was organized by Salsinger and Lt. Col. Hight, Military attache in Berlin. This banquet was a success. Salsinger believes that the Japanese CI service was the best in the world. They had technicians 'sniffing around' everywhere, and, although they did not know everything about the German war machine even with regard to the CI, they knew all the information in the document pertinent to subject.
