Abstract of pertinent information:

"General Onodera. He proved unwavering in his faith in the person of Mr. Liem and conviction of indispensable collaboration with the Allies, despite all the happenings during the voyage. He said that the French Intelligence Captain, who had interviewed him at Naples, produced letters addressed to the French authorities by Colonel Gano, chief of staff of the Polish C in C in London, General Bor Kormansky (Konorowski), and by a Polish Brigadier in Italy, requesting that a Japanese friend of Poland be accorded friendly attention by the French ally. The general in reply to a question by the French captain stated that he had had no direct contact with Mr. Garnier, the contact having been made through a v. Bellegarde, who is a friend of Messing's. In the course of his conversations with the general, the French officer confirmed that Finns like Colonel Faasonen and Halma (?), whose rendition from Sweden had been requested by the Moscow government, were 'safe' in Paris."
