

ONODERA Makoto, Major General (1420/6851/1108/0207)

ONODERA acknowledged the invitation and attended the initial meeting of the Continental Affairs Research Institute held at 102 Wakamatsu-Kho, Shinjuku-ku, Tokyo, on 8 Jan 1952. This organization is headed and sponsored by DOI Akio, and its purpose is to revive the relationship among those former officers of the Japanese Imperial General Staff who composed the Soviet Desk. New sources of information suggested at this meeting of the Institute included postwar contacts with MARDING, PARSONEN, and HALLAMMA which have been re-established by ONODERA. Subject attended the inaugural meeting of the organization tentatively known as the Sakurada Kai, which met at the Sakurada Kaikan on 8 May 52, between 4:00 and 6:30 p.m. ZJJ-116, 23 May 52, SO-90134, III-48.3.

Subject attended the first research meeting of the Continental Affairs Research Institute on 6 Apr 52, at the Shiyu Club in the Seikai Keizai Kan, Ote-machi, Chiyoda-ku, Tokyo. ZJJ-92, 25 Apr 52, CE File III-48.1.

Subject recommended establishing connections with Police Reserve members HIROSE Eiichi and HASEBE Kiyoshi. ONOUCHI Hiroshi was appointed by DOI Akio and ONODERA to approach HIROSE and YASUNO Hideo to approach HASEBE. IBID.

ONODERA Makoto, former Major General is presumed to be heading the ONODERA Kikan, an organization from whom CRC has been receiving reports. FJJ-314, 18 Sept 53, CE III, 32.5)
