Specific - German espionage in Sweden

Dear Colonel Helm,

Referring to my letter of June 26, 1947 I have the honour to submit to you a list of Swedes, who served in the Waffen-SS during the war and who can be suspected of having given the Germans espionage information regarding Swedish military conditions.

As I pointed out in my letter of June 26, 1947, we are, however, above all interested in the persons, who were mentioned in the memorandum enclosed in that letter. We have postponed intentionally to take measures against Lindholm and his movement, because we hope to have some further proofs of the connections of the Swedish Nazi party with the German Nazis.
