Specific: Repatriation List

1. Attached hereto is a copy of the latest and supposedly final Repatriation List. Mr. Culbertson and a British Official presented the list to Foreign Minister ARTAJO personally the first part of November. As in the past, the Spanish authorities have stated they would like to discuss certain of the cases in the list with the Allied Authorities, but Mr. Culbertson has refused to enter into any discussions or make any compromises. It is his intention to bring the repatriation matter to a close as soon as possible.

2. During the first days after the List was presented, the Germans listed thereon were frightened into hiding. An employee in Sofindus (where BERNHARDT still has his office) reported that BERNHARDT did not appear at his office for several days and was thought to be hiding. The appearance of Walter Eugen ROSIG in Spain added to their general alarm. However, they have recently begun to lose their fear and are returning to their homes. BERNHARDT has been reported to be more confident than ever.
