1. Enclosed as attachments are CAMOUFLAGE reports Nos. 18-1-54 and 19-1-54, dealing with the ABN. These reports should be brought to the attention of Headquarters personnel interested in the ABN. The evaluations on the reports were made by the Source and should be disregarded.

2. Attachment A: This report tells mainly of the split within ABN, the possible dismemberment of that organization, and the appeal to BANDERA to replace STEZKO with another president, a thing which BANDERA refuses to do.

3. Attachment B: Note that in paragraph 2, 31 January 1954 was set as the final date for a solution before the opposition group within the ABN threatens to leave. To date we have no information regarding the outcome. Paragraph 6 tells of the trip which STEZKO made to Canada under an assumed name. We have no further details on this trip.
