1. Frankfurt files contain information on Stanislaw FRGAL, Vaclav SVANCAR, Vladimir PERELSKY, Maria Theresia TRASCN and Franz PRALA which confirms information given in reference. Our files also indicate that subject may be working for CSR Intelligence Service.
2. There are no traces of Herbert LUCHT, L. FACILEK, and EDUARDUS, Ladislav ZILIK and Emil ZEMAN.
3. Information on Ivan LCH, Karel STROMAJER, Willi WURICH, Franz SCHLECTISKY, Jan MAREK, Zdenek TRASCN and Alfred BAUER, is not suitable for transmittal to the RV.
4. FOR YOUR INFORMATION ONLY:
  - a. TRASCN and PERELSKY were former ZIPPERITES. PERELSKY was dropped because of lack of value in his reports. Both are rumored as being active with the Italian Intelligence Service.
  - b. FRGAL and SVANCAR were considered of interest to us but were dropped without being used. They may be of interest to CIC.
  - c. TRASCN was dropped by us without prejudice in October 1950.
  - d. Information on LCH, STROMAJER, WURICH, SCHLECTISKY, MAREK and BAUER in our files was received from other agencies and therefore cannot be passed to the RV.
