Subject transferred membership in the Army Intelligence Reserve Corps to Washington, D.C., on 10/19/51.</p> <p>DETAILS:</p> <p>Mr. A. A. [redacted], Investigator, Immigration and Naturalization Service, 3770 East Jefferson, Detroit, Michigan, made available the file on subject's second wife, JANINA TERESA SCHAUMIJS, on March 17, 1952. The following information concerning subject's second wife was contained in Immigration and Naturalization Service file, number A-7489751.</p> <p>JANINA TERESA SCHAUMIJS arrived in the United States on June 5, 1950, at New Orleans, Louisiana, aboard the S.S. General Haan. She was to be employed at 1251 West Pacific Coast Highway, Long Beach, California, and was sponsored by Mrs. H. WARRUEN at that address. She did not go to her original destination, but went to Detroit, Michigan, where she has resided at the following addresses:</p> <p>3385 East Hancock Avenue; 3402 East Garfield Avenue; 9636 Woodlawn; 13237 Mark Twain, all Detroit, Michigan.</p>

Subject's second wife indicated that she had a high school education, having attended elementary school and high school 1939 through 1942 at Kraslau, Latvia. She listed her employment from 1942 through 1950 as follows:

4/1945 to 5/1945	Unemployed, resided at Zeulemode, Germany
6/1945 to 8/1945	Displaced Persons Camp Kaufbeuren, Germany
9/1945 to 9/1946	Displaced Persons Camps Murnau and Puessen, Germany
9/1946 to 2/22/50	Telephone Operator, United States Army of Occupation Murnan, Germany

Subject's second wife's immigration to the United States was given assurance by the National Catholic Welfare Conference, New York, New York.

Subject's second wife indicated that from the time of her arrival in Detroit until January of 1952, she was employed as a housekeeper in the City of Detroit.

Informant Detroit T-1, of known reliability, stated on March 19, 1952, that he could furnish no further information concerning the Subject's second wife other than that Subject had been married in Washington early in February and was residing with his wife at 3081 Connecticut Avenue, Northwest, Washington, D. C.

Informant Detroit T-2, of known reliability, another governmental agency which conducts security investigations, stated on March 20, 1952, that the Subject had transferred his membership in the enlisted reserve, Army Intelligence Corps to Washington, D. C. Informant also stated that Subject's records were located at the Chief, District of Columbia, Military District, Building 246-A, Fort Meyer, Virginia.
