Director Video

Quote from each director on black background or photo background (use quotes from publication)

Director Overview

ON SCREEN: Narrator sits in studio with the director's portrait

- Director's name
- Tenure as director
- Snapshot of the director's legacy or contribution during tenure at CIA
 - Note: We could also try and come up with a word or phrase that best describes that director. So for Donovan "Father of Intelligence," Smith "The Manager" ... something along those lines. This could give the viewer a quick understanding of each director. We could work with the historians to nail down the word/phrase.

Before CIA

ON SCREEN: Historical images of director prior to joining Agency and other images for historical context; Narrator's voice in background for part of the overview

- Discuss director's early life/background prior to serving as CIA's director
 - o Education, career, lifestyle, personality characteristics

Tenure at CIA

ON SCREEN: Images with POTUS and other Agency leaders; images of director during tenure; Narrator's voice in background for part of the overview

- Historical climate when appointed director

- Accomplishments/challenges during tenure
 - Relationship with the president
 - o Impact on policy
 - $\circ\quad \text{Changes the director made} \quad$

Director Conclusion

ON SCREEN: Narrator sits in studio with the director's portrait; potentially cut to more images of director during tenure at CIA as narrator concludes (if there are enough photos available)

- Final summary of director
- Impact on CIA's history

Closing Screen

Quote from president (or other policymaker/leader) about director's contribution to Agency Quote fades; CIA Seal appears
