2. The Proposal

a. Mission - To provide a contractual arrangement for a donation to the [REDACTED] C

[REDACTED] for work leading to amnesia-inducing drugs. These drugs, which might induce amnesia for periods of time as long as 18 months would be administered to maximum custody type defectors, in lieu of holding them in custody during that time.

b. Discussion

(1) The [REDACTED] G.
[REDACTED], does not have facilities for the conduct of such research on a basis completely divorced from overt Government connection and control. On the other hand, Dr. [REDACTED] C
is, at the present time, actively studying the effects of such drugs for inducing amnesia [REDACTED] J
[REDACTED] This is, therefore, a unique opportunity to carry on a sterile research program without arousing suspicion.

(2) Dr. [REDACTED] C
would supervise the synthesis of these compounds and the clinical tests using them. He has on hand 200 grams of the parent substance (worth \$1,500) for synthesizing these drugs. With the sum recommended, he could engage two chemists, part time, to carry on the synthesis of clinical derivatives; he has such services available at the [REDACTED] B
Also, there is a person available to make clinical tests on [REDACTED] J
[REDACTED] C
[REDACTED] would also perform toxicity tests on animals as a parallel work.

(3) Even though this project may not succeed in producing drugs which will induce amnesia for periods of a year or more, it is very likely that some will be found which induce amnesia for periods of days or weeks. As such,
