General Nicolae Rădescu continues to pay a portion of the stipends of scholarships he has given certain Rumanian students in Paris, but since April 1949 his payments have been limited to 120,000 French francs per month. Athanasie Macu, a wealthy Rumanian living in Paris, pays 80,000 French francs per month to holders of Rădescu's scholarships.

Washington Comment: Athanasie Macu, residing at 39 Boulevard des Capucines, Paris, is known as a sympathizer with the Rumanian Iron Guard. He is a supporter of General Rădescu. Macu and his wife left Rumania on legitimate passports, which were allegedly purchased at great cost. He is currently engaged in business in France.
