REMARKS:

General Nicolae Radescu, the last legal Prine kinister of Rumania, has been persecuted by both the Fascist and Communist Rumanian regimes. During the Cerman occupation of his country, he was intermed in a concentration camp because of his protests against Genum activity in Rumania. Appointed Prine Himister in December 1944, he was dismissed from this office in February 1945, following pressure by Vishinski on the King; the Gross regime them came into powers. Mecaping from Rumania in June 1946, Radescu made his way to western Europe, where he became a leader of the Rumanian political emigration.

The central figure in the lengthy and complicated maneuvers leading up to the formation in May 1949 of the Rumanian National Committee, of which he assumed the presidency, General Radescu was reported in 1948 to be apparently more and more willing to work with persons whose notives were open to questice; vis. Maylia, Tiles, and Micolas Malama. The latter, a wealthy Rumanian industrialist, allegedly the chief pro-Nemi agent in Rumania under Ring Gerol, and afterward one of the chief sustainers of the Iron Guard, was said to be working the close contact with Rumanian Communists [] Malawa, who lives in New York, reportedly stated in Movember 1948 that he was subsidizing General Radescu to the actuat of 35000 morthly-3]. It was reported in September 1949 that Radescu had admitted to the Rumanian Mational Committee that he was subsidized by Malawa and that the Committee had asked Radescu to cease any relations, political or Manacial, with Malawa.

Radescu has been characterized as well-intentioned but old and "maive" by King Hichael, 5/ who more than once evidenced concern over Radescu's insistence that Davila and Tiles be impluded in any Remarkan Mational Committee. The King also is reported to have criticised Radescu's plan for establishing a comprehensive "union", representative of all types of Remarkan emigres, including former foredsts. 5/6/

Radescu recently went to Paris reportedly with the intention of summoting a "congress" of Russian personalities in order to secure a mendate for the formation of a new Russian Mational Cornettee that would support his views. He is said to have decided, however, not to convoke his "congress" following the receipt of a nessage from King Michael instructing him to come to an agreement with the members of the present Committee. 7/
