## The Strachritz Periad

11. Husni Za'im, the ner Syrian dictator; gave his support and confidence to Graf Strachwitz and appointed Colonel Walter Rauff as commis'sioner of security $\operatorname{Fith}$ the special task of reorganizing Syrian intelligence. Rauff is a former SS-Standartenfuehrer and had taken an active part in Za'im's putsch.
12. Graf Strachritz, Rauff, and nearly all other members of the German group were dismissed after Sami al-Hinnawi seized power in August 1949. In September 1949 there remained only 16 German officers, six of whom were pilots.

## Personalities

40. Colonel Walter Rauff (listed as RAPP in some instances), was an SS-Standartenfuehrer, served during World War II in Tunis; and as an active Gestapo man commanded the SS at Milan. He played a leading role in the German experts group in Syria prior to and curing Za'im's regime, was appointed comaissioner of security, and charged with rem organization of Syrian intelligence. He was dismissed after Za'im's fall and is reported to be in Ecuador.
