In the course of our regular ODACID contact with the Sub-Sahara Africa Desk of the German Foreign Office, we learned that an organization called the Arabo-African Society, Beich Strasse 89, Munich, headed by Herr Rechaberg (phonetic), had, on 24 May, invited one of the Gizenga government ministers from Bukava, the Congo, to visit the Federal Republic.</p> <p>2. Can MOG supply any information about this organization? Unfortunately, we did not learn the minister's name, but he is at least the representative of a leftist-oriented regime which neither the FedRep nor any other Western power recognizes. Hence, it is strange, to say the least, that he would be invited by a Munich group unless it is some sort of front organization. If this is so, we should like to have the fact established.</p> <p>3. On the other hand, if this Munich organization is respectable and yet has contact with the Gizenga regime, this may be of operational interest to the AF Division in its professed desire for all available information on that regime.</p>
