- I obtained an appointment to see General Viola at 1800 hours September 26 at which time I will carry out instruction contained in reftel.
- Political gossip and press are now taking for granted that a Junta decision has been made to expel Timerman and cancel his Argentine nationality. estimate is that if in fact this is not the case, the media and military opinion are being manipulated to make such a decision Eximum easier.
- In a discussion with Rabbi Meyer ** this afternoon I informed him of Department's policy re refuge and again reassured that I thought possibility of Timerman's being left unprotected in Buenos Aires
