SUBJECT : Request for ARTICECKE

1. This memorandum contains a request submitted for DD/P approval. Such request is contained in paragraph 2.

6 2. [REDACTED] requests permission to use ARTICECKE in the anticipated interrogation of [REDACTED]. Although straight interrogation methods would be used initially, we should be prepared to use ARTICECKE should regular means fail. [REDACTED] could be taken to [REDACTED] or [REDACTED] for the ARTICECKE phase which could be administered under medical cover. A [REDACTED] speaking CIA case officer is available in [REDACTED] as an interpreter.

3. [REDACTED]

4. If ARTICECKE is used, [REDACTED] agrees not to reinfiltre [REDACTED] regardless of the outcome of the interrogation. The agent could be held in safe-keeping by a [REDACTED] in [REDACTED] for an indefinite period of time. If, contrary to all indications, the operation proves to be clean, another agent could be reinfiltred to replace [REDACTED].

6 5. [REDACTED] feels that the ARTICECKE method is justified if it appears it is needed to get at the truth of the operation.
