Terrorists Bomb Diplomatic Installations in Argentina


Early in the morning of 25 April, an extremely powerful bomb exploded outside the British Embassy residence in Buenos Aires. The bomb was concealed in a Ford Falcon station wagon parked at a side door of the residence. The explosion killed a policeman, severely wounded a night watchman in a building next door and a maid inside the residence, and damaged cars and shattered windows in nearby buildings. Although no structural damage was done to the residence itself, the explosion was so powerful that parts of nine automobiles parked on either side of the station wagon were thrown as high as ten stories in the air and onto the roofs of nearby buildings. Thus far, no terrorist group has claimed credit for the act.

On 18 April another powerful bomb exploded by the door of the Chilean consulate in Mar del Plata, causing serious damage to that part of the building but no personal injuries. Police provided no further details. Argentine authorities feel, however, that the explosion was linked to the visit of General Augusto Pinochet, head of the Chilean military junta.

While it is not known who perpetrated the bombing of the British Embassy, British diplomats and installations probably rank high on the target list of nationalistic extremist groups in Argentina because of a dispute between the United Kingdom and Argentina over the ownership of the Falkland Islands. This long-festering quarrel has heated up in recent months owing to possible oil discoveries off the Falklands, and a few of the more nationalistic Argentine congressmen recently called for the forcible occupation of the islands.




