The interrogation report (.... LSX-33) on Johann SANITZER, the Amt. IV A 2 official from Vienna contains a certain amount of information about various not very important links which existed between German double-cross operations in Austria and the personnel of the Rote Drei. SANITZER refers in particular to a certain Manfred von GRIMM, son of the late Austrian Consul General to the Netherlands, The only point of interest is, that according to SANITZER, GRIMM was not only a Russian agent but was also working on behalf of the British Intelligence Service.
