THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION IS QUOTED VERBATIM			
<p>It is a matter of no little satisfaction that of all the Aemter of the R.S.H.A. this Amt - the most important from the G.I. aspect - is the one which has been most effectively dealt with from the point of view of arrests and liquidation. The biggest capture of course has been Brigadefuehrer <u>SCHELLENBERG</u>, the Amtschef. <u>SCHELLENBERG</u>, now at Camp O20, is talking freely, and there is no reason to disbelieve his own assessment of the present position of Amt VI, the most important point being that he has stated that no effective post-war measures have been successfully undertaken by Amt VI, although he does mention without amplification that I-netze had been organized in neutral countries, i.e. Portugal, Spain, Sweden, and Switzerland, but he does qualify this statement with the remark that the effective working of these I-netze depended on the survival of a central control in Germany itself, which of course no longer exists.</p> <p>.....</p> <p>The Zentralburo was an attempt to coordinate the work of the various Referate in Amt VI, and was <u>SCHELLENBERG'S</u> own effort to create a kind of personal cabinet for the supervision of Amt VI work in general. The Leiter of the Zentralburo was previously reported as being Dr. Schindowski, though <u>SCHELLENBERG</u> himself indicates in his chart of the R.S.H.A. that Sandberger was in charge. Of the personnel of the Zentralburo, Sandberger and Schueddekopf (previously of VI D) are under arrest.</p> <p>.....</p> <p>It should be noted that <u>SCHELLENBERG</u> has stated that VI A and VI Kult were merged in 1944. ....</p> <p>Similarly the <u>SCHELLENBERG</u> interrogation has led to the identification of most of the leading Amt VI personalities and agents in the Iberian peninsula.</p> <p>.....</p> <p>In addition information is coming in from other sources - <u>SCHELLENBERG</u>, <u>OHLENDORF</u>, etc - on the extent to which Amt VI used and failed to use VI WI for espionage purposes.</p>
