Joined Allgemeine SS (General Protection Squads) 1934, attained rank of Sturm-bannfuhrer (battalion commander) 1943. Was a member of NSDAP and SS. Member of Bavarian Police in 1923. In 1933 he became a member of the Political Section of this agency. When the Bavarian Police became part of Gestapo (Geheime Staatspolizei) he was sent to Bregenz, Austria. In 1938 headed Gestapo office in Innsbruck. Sent to the Hague as SD official. 1940.</p>   |  |  |

Now a devoted family man, leads a quiet, secluded existence. He is an excellent raconteur and also a devotee of codes and ciphers. | <p>56. ATTITUDES (ideological, political, including attitude toward U.S. and other countries)</p> <p>No great political interests since World War II. Bears no malice toward the US. Has cooperated fully in all matters, perhaps due in part to the attitude of his superiors, which is pro American. He was a key figure in das Englandspiel (Operation North pole). This operation involved the capturing of a Dutch national, serving as a British agent, who parachuted into Holland, was captured by Schreieder and doubled. Capture of all succeeding agents was accomplished by using captured codes and sending of misleading information by Gestapo. Imprisoned after the war, Schreieder was tried in Holland, acquitted by the Dutch, and returned to Germany in early 1949.</p> |  |  |
| <p>57. REPUTATION AND COMPETENCE (include financial status)</p> <p>Schreieder has an excellent reputation and has been offered higher posts than his present position. However, he has elected to stay in the Munich area.</p>   |  |  |
| <p>58. PREFERENCES (in food, drink, tobacco, hobbies, entertainment, etc. What tactics are most likely to succeed with subject?)</p> <p>Devotee of codes and ciphers both as a hobby and professional interest. Does not drink to any extent except on social occasions and then rather cautiously. Enjoys hearing and telling stories.</p>  |  |  |
