From August 1943 to May 1946 Subject reportedly served with the German Army. He was a member of the II SS Grenadier Panzer Brigade during August 1944 and subsequently served with the 6/SS Grenadier Panzer Regiment #38 (a Police Unit). The highest rank attained during his military service was Unterwachtmeister (Sergeant). On 28 August 1944 he was dispatched to Pogny, France and on 5 September 1944 was taken prisoner at Chaumont and subsequently interned by the British at PW Camp No. 17, registered as PW No. B737. He later was interrogated at "Wilton Park". At an undetermined date in 1946 he was released from British Captivity.
