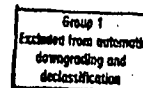

1. Major Leo Olsen of Wiesbaden OSI Headquarters brought the attached memorandum, dated 3 June 1963, and the attached yellow TWX on SCHUNACK to the office of the writer on 4 June. He stated he would like to discuss what further course of action should be taken in this information which reflects that SCHUNACK has a record in the Berlin Documents Center as an ex-SS official (Captain) and that in 1960 the LfV conducted surveillances on SCHUNACK's residence based on the apparent surreptitious transfer of packages from his automobile at night into the cars of visitors at his residence. The LfV dropped the case due to the lack of a specific allegation and because SCHUNACK was a high official in the Wiesbaden police and because no unfavorable information was disclosed in their file checks on the persons whose automobiles SCHUNACK had transferred the packages to. OSI's source made the observation that maybe SCHUNACK is under pressure from a hostile intelligence service who may know of his former SS position; and believes it would be appropriate if OSI were to initiate CIS coverage on SCHUNACK's mail and telephone. OSI's source is an LfV official.

2. It was recommended to Major Olsen by the writer that the substance of this information be furnished to KUBARK Headquarters and also to the Advance Secret Service Party arriving this weekend so that they maybe alerted to the possibility of a problem with SCHUNACK. It was further recommended that further action concerning SCHUNACK depend on the desires of the Secret Service in that they may desire further information or no action at all. Major Olsen was advised that the writer would believe it

appropriate to see if the names of the visitors to SCHUNACK's residence could be obtained from the LfV in order that they could be checked out through KUBARK Headquarters files. He advised that this could be done without difficulty.

3. If you concur in these recommendations we will work with OSI accordingly and the attached can be furnished Headquarters with the above explanation.
