Subject: SI and H Experimentation, 25 May 1951 (Room 20 - Building 13)

On Friday, 25 May 1951, conducted experiments in SI and H between 5:30 PM and 7:00 PM with who had worked excellently on Monday of this same week.

Since both

fully on Monday, it was decided to try one repeat test only

first tried the "hand-arm rising" test on

unable to do this successfully the last time.

very successfully did the "hand-arm rising" test.

also successfully repeated this test.

After a brief discussion, the "relaxing" test was repeated.

After about 7-10 minutes, both and reached a fairly deep somnambulistic state. Then tested both subjects on the "rigid arm" test-both successfully. Then by agreement transferred control of both subjects to then gave each subject the positive suggestion that they could only be induced by himself or fand that they would sleep quickly when directed in the future and then brought each subject awake by the 12345 method. Total sleep period about 20-25 minutes.

After a few minutes talk, then returned each subject to sleep for about one minute while the other subject watched.

In the above tests, both girls had some memory of events, but neither recalled the rigid arm test. No attempt was made by either to produce amnesia—this being reserved for subsequent tests.
