Subject: SI and H Experimentation, 3 October 1951.

On 3 October 1951, conducted experiments in SI and H in Rooms 20 and 5, Building 13. The subjects were

In view of the controversial behavior of the second and in their straight work and their post hypnotic, it was decided to again proceed along standard lines and continue the experimentation involving these individuals. It was also agreed that since the second had reached a much greater depth and a more consistent performance, she could be used as a balance against the activities of the others.

The first test tried was a very slow routine induction into an SI state by the state with a simple post hypnotic. In this test, apparently all individuals were successful and to all outward appearances, obtained a deep sleep state and responded to the post hypnotic suggestion of sleep. This test involved approximately fifteen minutes of time.

The second test was begun with all three subjects placed in a deep SI state and thereafter was told to open her eyes and proceed while asleep with to be be Room 3 while the other subjects maintained their sleep state. In this connection, it is the opinion of the writer and both that the other subjects when she left the room, was not in a trance state. It should further be noted that both and the stated that they had heard the instructions to although theyhad been specifically conditioned not to hear same by the writer.

to Room 3 and she was there given sleep instructions and post hypnotic instructions for approximately 20-25 minutes. In addition to the instructions regarding sleep, the post hypnotic suggestions were given. However, upon arrival in Room 3 and upon instructions to fall immediately asleep, she did specifically this. and the writer tried numerous post hypnotic suggestions with In general, these were successful although does not. react in the normal manner and attempts rationalization for all acts in which she engages. Both and the writer observed eye opening when she attempted to reach "normal that activity" again created the impression of "play acting". Again Was successful with her efforts but again activities were controversial.

After perhaps 15-20 minutes of such efforts, all subjects were assembled again in the Operations Room, placed under SI, and all post hypnotic suggestions were removed with precautionary instructions given.

Based on the results above, it is obvious that both will require a great deal of intensive efforts before they have reached a true somnambulistic state and can carry out advanced experimentation.
