AS OF 1100 HOURS LOCAL ON 13 OCTOBER 2003, THE GOVERNMENT OF BOLIVIA CONTINUES TO FACE VIOLENT OPPOSITION TO THE POTENTIAL SALE OF LIQUID NATURAL GAS, WHICH WOULD TRANSIT CHILE PRIOR TO ARRIVING IN NORTH AMERICAN MARKETS. THE BOLIVIAN WORKERS CENTRAL (COB), MOVEMENT TOWARDS SOCIALISM (MAS) AND OTHER OPPOSITION GROUPS, ALONG WITH THE ALTIPLANO CAMPESINO MOVEMENT LEAD BY FELIPE ((QUISPE)), ALIAS "EL MAILKU," HAVE LED VIOLENT DEMONSTRATIONS AGAINST THE GOVERNMENT FOR ALMOST ONE WEEK. (S//NF) 2. GOVERNMENT SECURITY FORCES CLASHED WITH OPPOSITION GROUP(b)(3) 12 OCTOBER 2003, LEADING TO THE DEATHS OF UP TO 26 DEMONSTRATORS, AND APPROXIMATELY 50 WOUNDED. AS A RESULT OF THESE DEATHS, DURING THE MORNING OF 13 OCTOBER 2003, THE VICE PRESIDENT OF BOLIVIA, CARLOS ((MESA)) ANNOUNCED TO THE PRESS THAT HE NO LONGER SUPPORTS THE GOVERNMENT OF BOLIVIA, AND THAT HE WOULD STEP DOWN AS VICE PRESIDENT. MESA IS CALLING FOR AN EMERGENCY SESSION OF CONGRESS TO ACCEPT HIS RESIGNATION. GOVERNMENT COALITION MEMBER REVOLUTIONARY LEFTIST MOVEMENT (MIR) PARTY, LED BY FORMER PRESIDENT JAIME ((PAZ)) ZAMORA, ANNOUNCED ON 13 OCTOBER 2003 THAT IT WAS PULLING OUT OF THE COALITION. THE NEW REPUBLICAN FORCE (NFR) PARTY, LED BY MANFRED ((REYES)) VILLA ALSO ANNOUNCED ON 13 OCTOBER 2003 THAT IT WOULD PULL OUT OF THE GOVERNMENT COALITION. (S//NF) 3. BEGINNING ON 9 OCTOBER, GROUPS OPPOSED TO THE GOVERNMENT SHUT DOWN THE CITY OF EL ALTO IN A "CIVIC STRIKE" CALLED TO PROTEST THE GOVERNMENT. EL ALTO IS CONTIGUOUS TO THE CAPITAL, LA PAZ, AND THE LA PAZ INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT IS LOCATED THERE. THE INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT IS CURRENTLY CLOSED TO COMMERCIAL FLIGHTS, AS CIVILIAN AVIATION COMPANY EMPLOYEES CANNOT REACH THE AIRPORT. THE DAILY AMERICAN AIRLINES FLIGHT(b)(1) FROM MIAMI HAS BEEN DIVERTED TO SANTA CRUZ, BOLIVIA. REPORTEDLY, THERE(b)(3) A NUMBER OF U.S. CITIZENS STRANDED AT THE INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT. THE ROADS FROM LA PAZ TO EL ALTO ARE ALSO BLOCKED BY DEMONSTRATORS. [REDACTED]

(S//NF) 4. AS OF 1100 ON 13 OCTOBER 2003 PROTESTORS ARE BLOCKADING DIFFERENT POINTS IN THE CITY OF LA PAZ, MAKING VEHICULAR TRANSPORT IN THE CITY DIFFICULT. SINCE 10 OCTOBER 2003, THERE HAS BEEN A SEVERE GASOLINE SHORTAGE IN THE CITY, WITH UP TO 4000 VEHICLES LINED UP AT 27 DIFFERENT GASOLINE STATIONS. SUPERMARKETS ARE RUNNING OUT OF FRESH PRODUCE AND PRICES ARE RISING. GASOLINE TANKER TRUCKS AND TRUCKS CARRYING PRODUCE HAVE BEEN BLOCKED FROM ENTERING LA PAZ DUE TO THE ROAD BLOCKADES MANNED BY PROTESTORS. ON 12 OCTOBER 2003 THE GOVERNMENT PROVIDED A MILITARY AND POLICE ESCORT TO ALLOW SEVERAL GASOLINE TANKER TRUCKS TO ENTER LA PAZ AND PROVIDE A LIMITED SUPPLY TO SOME GASOLINE STATIONS. f(b)(1)c TRANSPORTATION UNIONS DECLARED A STRIKE ON 13 OCTOBER 2003.
