1. Source A reports that Ante PAVELIC, at a recent meeting of approximately 40 former Croat government officials, revealed that he had been reliably informed that war in Europe is imminent.
2. PAVELIC stated that it was therefore necessary to lay aside all petty differences, and prepare for active participation in the coming conflict. He added that all necessary means for organization and participation would be made available to them. (Source A).
3. To the surprise of everyone present, PAVELIC assured the group that TITO has been in the service of the United States and British intelligence agencies for several years. (Source A).
4. PAVELIC requested that the matters discussed at this meeting be kept confidential. A person who attended the reunion advised Source A that PAVELIC appeared to be well informed. Moreover, he is certain that the former head of the Croatian Independent State frequently meets with Colonel Otto SKORCZY and General Adolf GILLAND.
5. Source B confirms that the meeting took place, but adds that PAVELIC described a pessimistic picture of the European political situation. PAVELIC is also concerned with the illness of his wife who recently was admitted to a hospital in Buenos Aires for medical attention.
