SUMMARY OF HIS REPORT: 1. Attached clipping from "France-Soir" purports to be the opinion of a former Luftwaffe Colonel REDEL, who has secretly returned to Germany. The source is "France-Soir" representative at BONN, George KRLBER.		
2. REDEL supposedly has contacted certain Wehrmacht generals to explain the ideas of Captain SKORZENY. Generals GUDFRAN and HAUSER supposedly agree with the thesis that "Germany cannot be effectively defended without a minimum of 100 divisions".		
3. REDEL stated that SKORZENY would shortly return to Western Germany and that they would have a conference.
