SUBJECT: NEO-FASCIST MEETING IN SPAIN

1. SUPPLEMENTING SO-72584, A USUALLY RELIABLE JOURNALIST CONFIRMS THE MEETING IN THE ALCAZAR, TOLEDO, OF A NEO-FASCIST EUROPEAN GROUP. THE MEETING, SET FOR 28 SEPTEMBER, WAS ORGANIZED BY JEAN BAUVERD, FRENCH SWISS, WHO CALLS THE GROUP "EUROPEAN SOCIAL MOVEMENT," AND IS A SEQUEL TO A FIRST MEETING HELD AT MALMO, SWEDEN, IN THE SPRING.
2. THE SPANISH GOVERNMENT WILL HAVE DELEGATES AT THE MEETING. THE ALCAZAR WAS CHOSEN AS A MEETING PLACE AS SYMBOLIC OF THE FIRST DECISIVE DEFEAT OF COMMUNISM. THE HERO OF THE ALCAZAR, LT. GEN. JOSE MOSCARDI, WILL BE HONORED AT A BANQUET FOLLOWING THE MEETING.
3. TWENTY DELEGATES WILL ATTEND, REPRESENTING ELEVEN COUNTRIES. OTTO KORZENEY WAS INVITED TO ATTEND BUT IT WAS UNCERTAIN WHETHER HE WOULD ACCEPT. KORZENEY ASKED THE PRESS, IN PUBLISHING THE STORY OF THE MEETING, WHICH WILL BE RELEASED AT 6 PM 28 SEPTEMBER, TO DENY AT THE SAME TIME A RUMOR SUPPOSEDLY SPREAD IN GERMANY THAT HE HAD BEEN ARRESTED AT THE SPANISH BORDER AND NOT PERMITTED TO ENTER SPAIN.
4. SOURCE CLAIMS THAT ONE NAME, ATTENDING THE MEETING AS REPRESENTATIVE OF THE GERMAN WEEKLY SPIEGEL, IS KNOWN BY THE ALLEGATES TO BE A FRENCH INTELLIGENCE AGENT.
