Upon his recent return from Egypt, Otto SKORZENY was queried by a British newspaperman in Madrid regarding the great number of German officials instructing in the Egyptian Army. SKORZENY is reported to have replied that there are no more than thirty-four such officials in Egypt and that they are paid a salary equivalent to 11,000 pesetas per month. SKORZENY also added that none of the thirty-four officials serving in the Egyptian Army as instructor is of outstanding renown and assured at the same time that none of them would serve in guerrilla operations.
