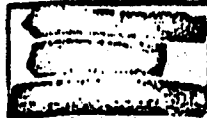

5. [] spent the week 19-26 September in Spain mainly to visit his friends at the European Documentation Center and to discuss radio broadcasts to Eastern Europe. [] met with CASTRO-Parinas of the Spanish National Radio. An American, Iru PEEK, was present at this meeting as technical director of the Eastern Europe Branch. The Spaniards plan thirty minutes of German language broadcasts on two short-wave transmitters each evening. [] was offered ten minutes of this time and plans to use it for six-ten German broadcasts. [] reported that several American representatives of Radio Liberation were in Spain to arrange for setting up a powerful transmitter in the Pyrenees.

6. While in Spain [] met with SKORZENY at a small luncheon in the company of the Marquis de VALDEIGLESIAS. SKORZENY expounded on the current German nationalist theme - closer ties with Russia in order to obtain the position of balance of power between East and West. SKORZENY said that he is working closely with COLON BONIN and his group. SKORZENY also boasted of his close ties to official and unofficial Americans in Spain.
