<p>...2. This report reflects that "on April 20, 1952 CAESARIS and Identity 1 met with fifteen or twenty German businessmen in Minden, Westfalen, to discuss "German cooperation with the world." CAESARIS, allegedly sent to Germany by Identity 2, had similar meetings in Hamburg shortly after arrival in West Germany. CAESARIS also was supposed to have met with Otto SKORZENY who came from Spain to discuss "mutual problems." With Identity 1, CAESARIS allegedly met Otto Ernst REMER and Dr. Fritz DORLS in Hannover the previous week. Shortly afterwards, some fifty delegates from all Germany received new orders from the Hannover S.R.P. Identity 1, CAESARIS, REMER, DORLS, SKORZENY and Dr. Hjalmar SCHAET and other prominent Germans, mostly former Nazis, were believed to be organizing a Deutsche Feuhring on a West German wide basis....</p> <p>Identity 1- Hans RUDEL</p> <p>Identity 2- Juan D.
