2. I checked with [] on what information he might have on Otto SKORZENY re a report received here that he was making regular weekend trips to Egypt.

3. [] had the following to say re SKORZENY. He had entered Spain illegally from Portugal after the end of WW II and had aided the passage of many Nazis through Spain; particularly a group of German army officers to Egypt and a group of naval officers to Argentina. Each of these groups are now influential on the respective general staffs of these two countries. Later on, SKORZENY became the representative in Spain of several German companies and maintains an office in Madrid. [] says that about four or five years ago, SKORZENY began receiving the active protection of the Falange and although many of his activities are still suspicious, the [] have not been able to keep tab on his actions since that time. [] considers him to be a dangerous individual and regrets the fact that he cannot make at least occasional checks on him.
