Note: from Jun '45 interrogation of Christian BAUMANN: SS Oberfuehrer SOMMER ambitious; formerly Leiter of an SD Oberabschnitt in Hamburg, Deputy General Grenzinspekteur in RSHA Amt IV; last seen 5 May 45 at Flensburg and said he was going to be attached to Regierungspraesident in Schleswig to form a Grenzschutzkorps on German-Danish frontier; was mbr of Nordstab, RSHA formed Apr '45; SOMMER did all the work of General Grenzinspekteur; he and his staff given task of bringing about better frontier control and of creating unified Grenzschutzkorps; instead of applying themselves to task of practical frontier control they spent their time elaborating never and more complicated procedures for frontier crossings, and thus illegal traffic increased enormously.

1951: EOD w/Zipper shortly before Sep '51; worked on clarification of illegal connections of REAL Film Co. (UJ-DROLLERY #1204, case GRETCHEN).

1952: Feb: Otto SKORZENY rpt to [] Station "SOMMER (V-2857)...from organisation Gehlen, supplied general news from Bonn to August MORITZ Russian spy net...SOMMER is not to be trusted, he is perhaps more on the Russian side... under SOMMER works SOMMER, former SD chief of Hamburg."
British rptd UWE WHELEN claimed ability procure for Otto SOMMER copies of

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contractual agreement, which would be in French, and SOMANN to sell to an unspecified agency. British attitude interpreted as belief Zipper bought or obtained such material for passing to Russians for political purposes or D/A build-up.

Apr: British rptd former Oberf SS/ED SOMANN to be contact of suspected d/a MORITZ; SOMANN suspected by BIS of working on behalf FIS; later BfV rptd material they read indicated Zipper agent SOMANN, involved in MORITZ case, had supplied British with material on KAUMANN case and SOMANN suspected as triple agent working for British, Zipper and LfV Hamburg; MORITZ arrested 11 Apr 52; POB advised Zipper that MORITZ stated under interrogation he had been warned by SOMANN of impending British arrest, so POB suggested Zipper re-assess SOMANN to whom MORITZ handed large batch of material before his arrest; British doubted Zipper's good faith; in Oct, Dr. LAU, investigating judge of Attorney General's office in Hamburg who had been briefed by BfV, correctly interrogated SOMMER and SOMANN but with consideration for Zipper's interest. (Note: POB records indicate SOMMER and SOMANN usually read duty rr tickets during same periods).

Apr: Rolf Valentine DRUCKER, RIS defector, became sub-agent of SOMANN, but was arrested while carrying out a mission; SOMANN effected his release from Hanau Criminal Police, at which time SOMANN described himself as a former German counter-intelligence officer of field grade rank; subsequently LfV circulated report that SOMANN @ LANGE and DRUCKER were suspected DDR or Sov Russia agents in view their suspicious activities, lack of German documentation but possession of American and English identification.

May: after he fabricated several reports, @ DRUCKER arrested thru BfV assistance.

1953: SOMANN transferred to GV B, UV 17 according to 17 Sep 53; Easter List; prior transfer he was to submit proposals for approaching Jaergen THOST, deputy Forestry Minister of Neubrandenburg district, Neustrelitz, DDR.

OPERATIONAL ALIASES: Othar LANGE; Othar SEIDEMANN also known as Hans SOMMAN

GV L: s/o Hamburg; Target III-Bruderschaft, police and SD, Kreiss Stellvertreter BV Leiter Nord. Attempted in 1952 to join BRUDERSCHAFT but they suspected him to be an agent, possibly RIS.

GV B: UV 17; living and a/o: Hamburg, V-mannfuhrer.
