The above photograph is of the cover of the Russian Passport which is the subject of this attachment. The printing on the right hand side of the photo is simply the word, "PASSPORT" repeated in five languages as follows:

1. Russian
2. believed to be Ukrainian
3. not identified
4. believed to be Georgian
5. believed to be Armenian

The cover was measured and found to be 4 3/4" X 3 5/16". It is bound in dark green cloth. The inner pages of the document are of light green watermarked paper with fine engraving as shown in photos on following pages of this attachment. The water marks are of salmon pink.
