Has established contact with the Prince of Liechtenstein who makes frequent trips to Vienna, Munich, Salzburg, & into Switzerland.

TARBABY has not been assigned any specific long-term task but is still being retained on an active status because of his excellent contacts and his past services.

TARBABY

Jewish Austrian banker who lived at one time in the U.S., returned to Austria just prior to First WW; interned as an enemy alien during that war; prosecuted under the Nuremberg Racial Law, forced to go on two trips for RSHA in connection with RSHA financial operations.

Although not strictly an agent, he has been utilized as means of meeting other persons. Since entertains a great deal (Germans & US) his portress offers opportunities of meeting people unofficially.

Contacts developed thus far include Major McCarthy of OMEB Property Control Division, Col. LORD of OMEB Property Control, Col. GIDDENS of OMEB Transportation, Major O'Donnell of OMEB Public Safety, Col RICHTERS of Engineers, Dr. OHRENSTEIN and others.

So far he has not been employed to invite specific German officials, and he has not been paid. If he acts on instructions in future, he will have to be provided with food and liquor. TARBARY is an elderly, Jewish, American bantler and was formerly an American citizen. He is considered trustworthy & pro-American and is decidedly anti-Communist and anti-Soviet. He was first contacted by AB-19 and later handled by AB-43 (Holzman)

ODDI EUCOM received letter on SCHWEND who was used on bird-dropping ops in Holland from July to Nov. 45.

Charles C. SPITZ, Munich Jew, aided SCHWEND in persuading Americans not to prosecute SCHWEND for Nazi activities.

HGM-A-365 24 Feb. 48

SPITZ, at present being investigated by Dutch and Belgian authorities due to his war-time art looting activities, is living in Munich and possibly in touch with SCHWEND.

Is engaged in questionable financial deals and in minor scale black market operations and is quite friendly with high-ranking officers of ORGEB.
