3. KUNZE said TIEBEL finally had broken and confessed that he had been a witting Soviet agent for many years. KUNZE said she had none of the details, but thought we could get them the following week. KUNZE also said she had heard that, strange though it might seem, TIEBEL would be released under bond over the Christmas holidays and then picked up again early next year for further interrogation. and prosecution. She said she was not aware of the legal technicalities involved, but that TIEBEL was a lawyer had found a few loopholes concerning his arrest and also had convinced the prosecution that there was no danger that he would bug out.
