Character Assessment of Sven Gunnar Treuhoff

Mr. Treuhoff has proven himself to be extremely discreet and tactful. He has never caused embarrassment to this organization even when completing the most difficult assignments requiring the utmost of tact. His discretion and caution gives him the appearance of being not too mentally alert; he does not seem capable of profound analyses or high level theory. However, he does present an air of good common sense while completing his assignments.

Mr. Treuhoff plans to follow a designing career, and has continued his architecture studies at the Darmstadt Institute of Technology at his own self sacrifice. The fact that he completed his high school studies while recuperating from war wounds and has continued his architecture studies part time over a period of almost five years points up perseverance qualities he has demonstrated in his work with our organization. If all goes as planned, he will complete his architecture studies in January 1954. His goal is to become a graduate architect prior to his emigration to the United States, as he feels a degree will give him a far better start toward a "new life" in the United States.

He speaks, reads, and writes, besides his native Estonian, German and English. His English is not perfect; however, he is able to set forth more difficult points of conversation when more simple sentence structures are utilized. He listens to English language radio broadcasts and has read English language novels and newspapers. He knows Russian, Finnish, and French to a lesser degree.

He can be recommended highly for United States immigration.
